

## Emergency Mistral Oil Filter

Should you find yourself in dire need of an oil filter for a Mistral, or other car using the late cartridge type, you can use two of the felt type filters for a TR-7. Bap-Geon part number is 11-14009. To use the TR-7 filters, remove the end caps from your old filter and place one on each TR-7 filter. Then stack the TR-7 filters such that the end caps are on the top and bottom, with the bare filters touching in the middle. Try to align the filter ribs at the middle to avoid any bypass of the filter. The "new" filter is now ready to install, but without any springs in the canister. Save the canister springs if you want to go back to an original type filter. This may be a messy job, but it will get the car back on the road.
